The newly upgraded Legends Field features a grass infield with state-of-the-art Washington Ball Mix brick clay batter's boxes and was upgraded in 2026 ahead of the 2026 Baseball Canada Nationals. The field also includes a warning track, full irrigation system for both the infield and outfield, and a new yellow protective fencing topper. The field was named to honour those who have made a significant contribution to baseball in the Summerside area. The Legends Field monument was erected to recognize those whose names appear on the monument's bronze plaque in right field.

- **Very Important Volunteer (VIV) Field -**

The newly upgraded Very Important Volunteer (VIV) field has been a significant recreation space in Summerside since 1930 and has hosted many provincial, regional, national, and international sporting events. This field, renovated in 2015 and again in 2026 will now include new Player Dugouts, Bullpens, new outfield fencing and new artificial turf infield.

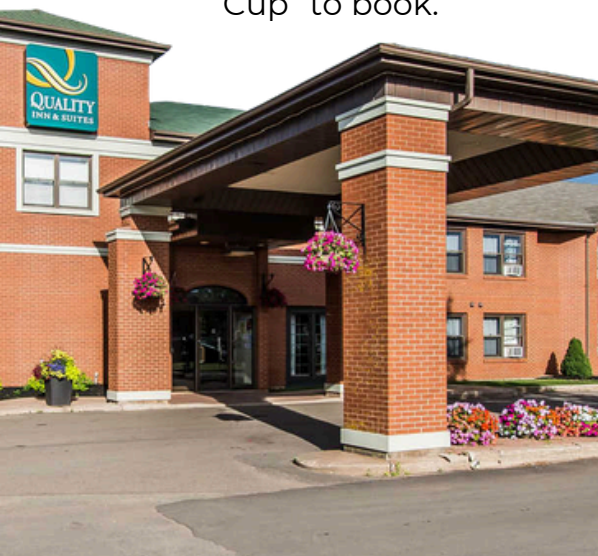
